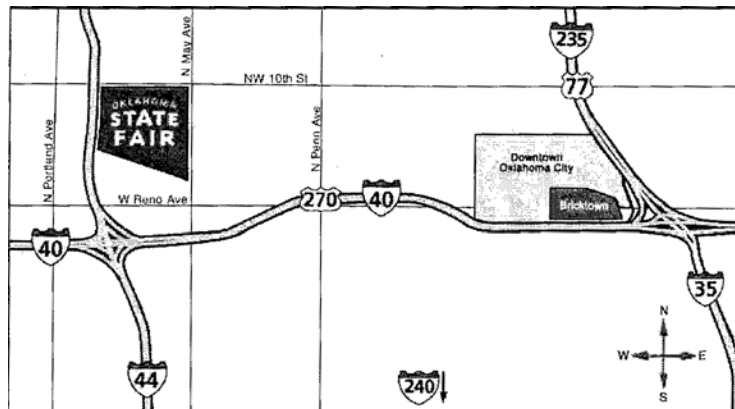

## MEMORIAL TROPHY

IVAN E. ROWE MEMORIAL TROPHY - *Awarded to Western Pleasure Open Champion*

The Ivan E. Rowe Memorial Trophy was established in 1974 by Jean Rowe her son, Bob and daughter Nita, as a continuing memorial to their husband and father, Ivan E. Rowe. Mr. Rowe was a charter member of the Oklahoma Arabian Horse Club and served many years as its leader, as well as president of the International Arabian Horse Association. The original Italian made ceramic trophy, which had become fragile over the 23 years it was awarded, was replaced in 1997 with a bronze entitled "Wild Fire" by artist, Carol Cunningham.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The trophy is a "traveling" trophy awarded each year. It is the responsibility of the recipients to have the trophies insured while they are in their possession. The trophies are to be returned to the Oklahoma Arabian Horse Club by April 1st in the year following receipt of these awards, if the recipient is NOT attending the current show

## HIGH POINT SPORT HORSE

Sport Horse High Point and Reserve High Point awards will be given for both the Purebred and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian divisions. An embroidered bridle bag will be awarded to the High Point winners and an embroidered garment bag will be awarded to the Reserve High Point winners. These awards are being sponsored by Chili Pepper Farm. The awards will be announced and presented Friday afternoon in Center Ring at the end of the afternoon session. The show photographer will be present.

TO QUALIFY, points will be awarded for all classes in the Sport Horse Division. Points will follow the horse. The horse will accumulate points based on class placings. The class placings are first through sixth so the points will be awarded as follows: 1st = 6 points, 2nd = 5 points, 3rd = 4 points, 4th = 3 points, 5th = 2 points, and 6th = 1 point. The horse with the highest number of points will be awarded the bridle bag. The horse with the second highest number of points will be awarded the garment bag.

## **MOST CLASSIC HEAD**

**To the Winner of the “Arabian Most Classic Head” class**, in addition to the ribbon and trophy, a \$50 cash award will be given. Cash award sponsored by White Wolf Farm.

## **RANDOM CASH GIVE-AWAY BONUS**

A random cash bonus will be given in the ATR Arabian and HA/AA Mounted Native Costume classes in addition to the 12 BONUS classes during the Championship session. **You will be eligible for the Cash by just riding in the Class.** The winning number will be drawn during the class and announced at the end of the class. Any rider in the class could win—you do not have to place. See the Class Schedule - the eligible classes are designated at the end of the class name by the word 'BONUS' with the amount of the award.

## CLASS INFORMATION

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT US EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION, INC. RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. Classes covered by AHA Rules will be judged according to those rules. Questions not covered by USEF, Inc. rules or Arabian Horse Association rules will be decided by the Show Committee whose decision will be final.

Horses placing first, second or third in certain qualifying classes are **required** to show in the respective championship classes or **forfeit winnings**. Exempted are veterinarian excused horses. If a rider qualifies more than one horse, he/she may choose the one he/she wishes to enter the championship class. To be eligible to show in Performance Championship class, a horse must be properly entered, shown and judged in one qualifying class in the same division or section.

**EQUITATION:** All equitation classes shall be governed in accordance with USEF Rules as modified by the AHA Equitation Rules in the current AHA Handbook. The Handbook may be obtained by writing AHA, 10805 E. Bethany Drive, Aurora, CO 80014.

**AHA MEDAL CLASSES:** All AHA Medal Classes are open to juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1. Each AHA Medal class must have a minimum of three (3) competitors with proper appointments in order to have AHA Medal awarded. In AHA Medal classes with less than three (3) competitors, AHA Medal points will be earned. (Article 1982)

**AHA SADDLE SEAT EQUITATION MEDAL CLASS:** Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF EQ119, Test 1-15 or EC equivalent. Markers shall not be used. (BOD 1/97).

**AHA WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP MEDAL CLASS:** All contestants will perform rail work and a pattern work as outlined in USEF AR220 and AR224.

**AHA HUNTER SEAT NOT TO JUMP MEDAL CLASS:** Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual test from EQ113.

**SADDLE SEAT & REINING SEAT EQUITATION:** Saddle Seat judges are encouraged to request 2+ tests from USEF EQ119, Tests 1-15. Reining Seat judges are encouraged to request 2+ tests from USEF EQ125.

**WALK/TROT EQUITATION 10 AND UNDER (any seat):** Open to riders 10 years of age and under. Stallions prohibited. As of 1/1/95, a rider must have never been judged in a class at a recognized competition that required canter or lope. No test to be called. See USEF Rule Book for proper attire. Saddle Seat and Hunter Seat: To be judged at a walk and trot. Reining Seat: To be judged at a walk and jog-trot.

**WALK/TROT PLEASURE 10 AND UNDER (any seat) -** Open to riders 10 years of age and under. Stallions prohibited. As of 1/1/95, a rider must have never been judged in a class at a recognized competition that required canter or lope. To be judged on attitude, manners, performance, suitability of horse to rider, quality and conformation. Country Pleasure, English Pleasure, and Hunter Pleasure: To be shown at a walk and normal trot. Western Pleasure: To be shown at a walk and jog-trot.

**UPHA ARABIAN BREEDS CHALLENGE CUP 17 & UNDER:** Open to all saddle seat equitation riders, 17 years of age and under, riding an Arabian Breeds mare or gelding. Arabians Breeds riders have the option of competing in the UPHA Challenge Cup National or Junior Championship at the American Royal and in their respective breed Championships, however, one win of a UPHA Challenge Cup will not qualify a rider for both Championships. Separate qualifications are required. Arabian Breeds riders can qualify for their respective breed Championships by placing first or second in a UPHA Challenge Cup designated for a particular breed or first through sixth in an open (17 & Under, 14-17, or 13 & Under) UPHA Challenge Cup class.

**NSH CLASSES:** Added prize money in the amount of \$340 is offered by the National Show Horse Registry. Prize money will be paid to the owner of record according to NSHR records within 30 days of the close of the show. Horse owners are required to provide show management with proof of NSHR registration. A copy of the official NSHR Certificate of Registration or Confirmation Letter must accompany your entry. **Pending registration will not be accepted.**

**TO BE ANNOUNCED CLASS (BUY-A-CLASS):** To buy a class, you must pay \$50 for the class, in addition to the regular class fees. All Buy-A-Class classes *must be purchased and paid for by entry closing date* so the other exhibitors may be notified. Classes will be sold on a first come-first serve basis (postmark date of entry - no telephone requests).

## GENERAL RULES OF THE SHOW

This horse show and every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. The official Rule Book of the USEF will prevail for this show. This Premium List is based on rules of the current Rule Book. Any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become a part of this Premium List. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of all appropriate rules, and is subject to all rules as they apply. Questions not covered by these organizations will be decided by the Show Committee and its decision will be final.

**USEF MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:** Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. *EC 7/21/08 Effective 12/1/08* **A COPY OF YOUR USEF MEMBERSHIP CARD MUST BE INCLUDED WITH YOUR ENTRY.**

**AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT:** Any owner, trainer, driver, rider or handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individual's horse(s) at the show must be a member of AHA or pay Single Even Membership fee of \$30.

**ARENAS & FOOTING:** The Ring 6 arena size is 120' x 250'. The warm-up arena size is approximately 80' x 150' . All arenas have loam type dirt footing.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither the Oklahoma Arabian Horse Club nor the Oklahoma State Fairgrounds will be responsible for any loss, personal injury, or damages to horses exhibited or for any article of any kind of any nature that may be lost or destroyed or in any way damaged. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee, but solely at the risk of the exhibitor who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal, or property occasioned by him or his agents or employees, or by an animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Oklahoma Arabian Horse Club and the Oklahoma State Fairgrounds against any and all loss, damage and liability thus occasioned, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. **THE SUBMITTING OF ANY ENTRY FORM TO THE SHOW SECRETARY SHALL CONSTITUTE AN ACCEPTANCE OF THE PROVISION HEREIN SET FORTH.**

**ENTRIES:** Entry forms must be filled out entirely. If a farm name is used as owner, the farm must have an AHA Farm/Ranch Membership and the Farm/Ranch Membership must be used as the AHA owner number. **A PHOTOCOPY OF ALL AHA MEMBERSHIP CARDS AND USEF MEMBERSHIP CARDS MUST ACCOMPANY YOUR ENTRY FORM.** Every exhibitor, rider, driver, handler and trainer or his/her agent(s) must sign the entry form. In the case of a rider, driver or handler under the age of 18, his/her parent or guardian, or if not available, the trainer, must sign the entry blank on the minor's behalf. (See GR908.2) The Social Security Number or Federal Identification Tax Number of the

Owner must be included on the entry form. *There will be a \$10.00 penalty fee assessed for incomplete entry forms.*

**OPERATION OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardians(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with USEF Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**ACCIDENT PREPAREDNESS PLAN:** The show complies with Article GR1211.5f of the USEF Rules. An off-duty OKC EMT is on the show grounds during each session of the show. In addition, an OKC ambulance, if needed, will be summoned by a call to 911. Should the EMT or ambulance be needed, contact the Show Office or the show arena Paddock Manager. The EMT or the ambulance will be contacted. The Show Veterinarian can be contacted by the show office. **AN ACCIDENT PREPAREDNESS PLAN WILL BE POSTED IN THE SHOW OFFICE AND AT THE PADDOCK.**

**REGISTRATION PAPERS: A PHOTOCOPY OF BOTH SIDES OF THE REGISTRATION PAPERS OF EACH HORSE ENTERED MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THE ENTRY FORM. COPIES OF PENDING APPLICATIONS MUST BE INCLUDED WITH ALL NECESSARY SIGNATURES.** Copies of the registration papers will be returned to exhibitors when they pick up their numbers. In case of sale or lease, it is required that a copy of the contract of sale or lease, or a statement from the current owner, be submitted with the copy of the registration papers. SHOW PACKETS WILL NOT BE ISSUED WITHOUT RECEIPT OF COPIES OF REGISTRATION PAPERS.

**POST ENTRIES:** Post entries will be accepted if made at *least ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF THE SESSION IN WHICH THE CLASS IS TO BE HELD.* The post entry fee is \$35.00 per horse. If a horse is entered by April 2, 2010, additional classes may be entered at the show and not be subject to the post entry fee.

**WITHDRAWING ENTRIES:** Entries may be scratched from the show PRIOR TO April 2, 2010, with a total refund. After that date, withdrawals accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate of inability to show will receive refunds of *class entry fees only.* **Any exhibitor who fails to officially scratch an entry prior to the start of his/her class is subject to a \$10 fine** (Added to bill and will need to be paid prior to leaving.).

**REFUSAL OF ENTRIES:** The Show Management will be governed by USEF Chapter 9, GR914, with respect to refusal of entries for this show. **Any individual who had insufficient fund checks for ANY Oklahoma Arabian Horse Club sponsored event in 2007 or 2008 must pay show fees in advance by cash or certified funds or their entries will be returned.**

**SHOW ACCOUNTS:** Show accounts will only be available to owners and trainers who leave a signed check made payable to OAHHC with the Show Secretary, otherwise all fees must be paid as incurred.

**INDEBTEDNESS TO SHOW:** Any exhibitor who fails to settle his indebtedness to this show will automatically be barred from taking part in any USEF Recognized Show until settlement is made. Any exhibitor who fails to settle his indebtedness in full to a FARRIER or VETERINARIAN for his/her services during show BEFORE LEAVING THE FAIR-GROUNDS will be barred from taking part in future shows.

**BAD CHECKS:** There will be a \$25.00 handling fee charged for any returned checks. Action in accordance with USEF Chapter 15, Art. GR913, will be taken against any owner, exhibitor or trainer who does not make a returned check good.

**SHOW OFFICE HOURS:** Show office will be open Thursday, April 15, 2010, at 3:00 – 8:00 p.m. Scheduled hours of operation will be posted at the Show Office. Show office telephone number during the show will be: 405-948-6788.

**BARN OFFICE HOURS:** Barn office will open Thursday, April 15, 2010, at 8:00 a.m.

**ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE:** Stalls will be available Thursday, **April 15, 2010 at 8:00 a.m.** **EARLY ARRIVALS ARE DISCOURAGED** If you must arrive early, please call the Barn Manager so that you can make accommodations at local stables that have facilities for transient horses at **your own cost**. BARN WILL BE LOCKED BEFORE WED. IF YOU ARRIVE WEDNESDAY, YOU WILL BE CHARGED A PRORATED SHARE OF THE COST OF THE BARN AND EACH STALL YOU USE.

**SECURITY** NO SECURITY IS PROVIDED BEFORE 9:00 P.M., April 15. THE FAIR-GROUNDS AND/OR OAHG IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ITEMS LEFT UNATTENDED. Horses must be removed from the show grounds by 10:00 P.M., Sunday, April 18, 2010, *unless specific arrangements have been made with the Show Management and the Oklahoma State Fairgrounds*. THERE IS NO SECURITY AFTER 7:00 A.M., Sunday, April 18, 2010.

**HEALTH REGULATIONS:** All horses must have a negative Coggins Test dated within twelve (12) months (must be original not photocopy). All horses must also be accompanied by an Official Health Certificate issued within 30 days of arrival that identifies the animals listed, including all vaccinations, and date and results of required tests. THE ABOVE ITEMS SHOULD BE CARRIED WITH YOU - DO NOT FORWARD WITH YOUR ENTRY. All regulations of the State of Oklahoma, Animal Health Division, must be observed by any animals brought into the Fairgrounds.

**VETERINARIAN INSPECTION:** All animals are subject to a physical inspection by the Show Veterinarian as a safeguard against communicable disease. All animals may also be inspected by the official USEF Steward.

**STALLS AND BEDDING: ALL HORSES MUST BE STALLED.** Stalls are sliding doors on asphalt floors. Stalls will be assigned as entries are received on official entry blanks and NO CHANGES WILL BE MADE BY EXHIBITORS. Stalls and alley ways must be kept clean. Feed and bedding will be available in front of Barn #4. You may place an advance order by calling 405-948-6786 or by faxing your credit card and order to 405-948-6787. Delivery will be made to your stall area. YOU MUST PAY YOUR FEED BILL IN CASH/CREDIT CARD UPON DELIVERY. IF YOU WISH TO BE STALLED WITH SOMEONE, PLEASE MAKE THAT NOTATION ON YOUR ENTRY FORM AND MAIL ENTRIES **TOGETHER** IN SAME ENVELOPE. Empty and unassigned stalls are **NOT TO BE USED FOR ANY PURPOSE WITHOUT RENTAL FEES BEING PAID AND ASSIGNMENT OFFICIALLY MADE**. Unassigned stalls will be checked periodically by Show Management and State Fairgrounds personnel to ascertain unauthorized use. Any such use will be billed to those individuals using the stalls. NO SAWDUST or similar fine-particle bedding will be permitted. Straw bedding is allowed, as are coarse shavings.

**FARRIER:** A farrier will be available on the show grounds beginning April 16, 8:00 AM.

**DISCIPLINE:** Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, groom, rider, driver, or member of the family of the person participating in the show will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves to itself the right to remove a groom, horse, handler, rider or driver from the show without being liable for compensation of damages.

**CRUELTY TO AND ABUSE OF A HORSE:** Refer to USEF Chapter 8, GR839

**DRUGS AND MEDICATIONS:** The Drugs and Medication Rule contained in Chapter 4 of the USEF Rule Book will be enforced. Horses in competition will be subject to examination by a licensed veterinarian appointed by USEF. Said appointed licensed veterinarians, with approval of USEF, may appoint a technician to perform certain duties under Chapter 4, GR402. The examination may include physical, saliva, urine, blood tests or any other test or procedure at the discretion of said licensed veterinarian necessary to effectuate the purposes of this rule. These representatives must be treated with respect. All halter, performance, and equitation horses will be charged \$15 per horse (\$7.00 Drug & Medication, \$8.00 Administration) to defray the expenses of testing.

**PROTESTS:** A protest must be filed as set forth in USEF Chapter 6 GR603. USEF protest deposit fee is \$200 if made by a Federation member or \$300 if made by a non-member and is due at time protest is filed.

**JUDGES:** A single judge system will be used in all classes. In the event that due to an illness or failure of a judge to attend the show or to perform their duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one who is officially designated in the Premium List, according to the USEF Chapter 10. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive or made with intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging and any exhibitor may be barred from the show for this offense by the Show Committee. No contact shall be made with the Judges during the period of the show unless accompanied by a member of the Show Committee designated by the Committee for such purpose. Further, no exhibitor shall approach a Judge regarding a decision unless he first obtains permissions from the Steward, who shall arrange an appointment with the Judge at a proper time and place. **NOTE:** Judge(s) must eliminate from judging consideration any horse which shows aggression or discontent toward its handler, rider or any person in the ring.

**ADMISSION TO THE RING:** No person will be permitted to enter the arena except as participants in the class, judges and their assistants, and the show photographer and assistants. Attendants will not be permitted in the arena unless summoned by order of the judge.

**NUMBER OF ENTRIES IN CLASSES:** In the event there are less than three (3) entries in a class, there will be no prize money awarded relative to that class. Exhibitors are given the option to withdraw from that class and their entry fee for that class will be refunded provided the exhibitor or authorized representative makes the withdrawal at the Show Secretary's office no later than one (1) hour before the start of the session in which that class is held. However, the Show Committee reserves the right to combine or split classes as deemed necessary.

**CALL FOR CLASSES:** Classes will be called promptly. Two minutes will be allowed after the first horse in the class enters the ring, after which time the gate will be closed. Exhibitors are cautioned against entering the same horse in successive classes. **NOTE:** Due to unforeseeable problems with the mechanical devices, the paddock and barn calls over the PA system must be considered a **COURTESY**. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. While every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system to carry the class calls, no protest will be upheld nor will any section be changed on the basis of a PA malfunction.

**AGE OF HORSE:** For competition purposes any horse is considered to be one year old on the first day of January following the actual date of foaling.

**AMATEUR OWNERS:** Combined ownership is not permitted in Owner or Amateur Owner classes unless all owners are members of the same family. Leased horses are not eligible.

**AMATEURS:** Every rider, driver and handler having reached his/her 18th birthday prior to

December 1, 2009 must possess a current USEF Amateur Certification or be eligible for and have made application for one with the Show Secretary at least one hour prior to riding/driving in Amateur to Ride/Drive Classes. USEF Amateur Applications are available in the Show Office.

**STALLIONS:** Purebred Arabian stallions may be shown by ladies and children except in Halter Showmanship, Leadline, Walk-Trot Pleasure or Equitation, and UPHA Challenge Cup.

**MAIDEN, NOVICE AND LIMIT RIDER/DRIVER/HORSE:** Maiden, Novice and Limit/Rider/Driver/Horse classes are open to riders/drivers/horses who have not won one (1), three (3), six (6) first place ribbons respectively in a performance class at an Regular Member USEF or EC Arabian Division competition in the division in which they are competing. A Maiden/Novice/Limit entry is such from the date of the closing of entries.

**ADULT AMATEUR SELECT RIDER:** A rider may compete in the Adult Amateur Select Classes unless he/she has won any of the following awards: (1) A regional Top Five (or better) in the corresponding Open, AAOTR or JOTR class. (2) A National Top Ten (or better) in the corresponding Open, AAOTR or JOTR class. (3) Two Regional Top Five Awards (or better) in a corresponding Select AOTR or JOTR class. (4) National Top Ten (or better) in a corresponding Select AAOTR or JOTR class. (5) A rider who begins the USEF show year eligible to compete in these classes may continue to compete in them throughout that competition year regardless of winnings during the year. (6) Eligibility is determined by the winnings of the rider, not the horse.

**\$\$ - DESIGNATED SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES** Classes designated with \$\$ in front of their usual name are this show's designated sweepstakes classes. These classes are part of AHA's Breeder's Sweepstakes Program. Sweepstakes exhibitors may earn points by placing in these classes. These points will contribute to a Sweepstakes payout according to the program rules, if the annual enrollment fee has been paid prior to this show, for that horse. Non-Sweepstakes horses, while they do not participate in the points pay-out program, may, if otherwise qualified, enter those classes.

**WHIP ABUSE:** Excessive use of the whip on any horse in a stall, runway, schooling area, show ring or anywhere on the competition grounds before or during a show, by any person, constitutes a violation and renders the offender subject to penalty. ***Judge will be expected to enforce this in the arena.***

**WASHING HORSES:** Washing of horses will only be permitted in wash stall areas of Barn #1 or the outside wash areas. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCE WILL HORSES BE WASHED OR RINSED IN THE AISLES BETWEEN STALLS.

**VETERINARIAN:** A veterinarian is ON CALL. **Equine Medical Associates 405-348-3130**

**TRAILER PARKING:** Designated space for trailers will be lot NORTH of Barn area.

**RV PARKING:** Recreational vehicle and camper parking will be available at the State Fair RV Park at the rate of \$20-\$45 per night. Fee will be collected daily by a State Fair employee. Fee includes water and electric hook-up as well as a dump station. Restroom and showers are available at the site. All arrangements should be made by contacting the State Fair of Oklahoma, P.O. Box 74943, Oklahoma City, OK 73147, or call 405-948-6704 for information. Overnight camping is allowed only in the RV Park.

**DOGS AND PETS:** All dogs and other pets are **required to be on a leash** or secured while on the show grounds. THIS WILL BE ENFORCED - your cooperation will be appreciated.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following:

I AGREE that "the Federation" and "Competition" as used herein includes the Licensee and Competition Management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and Federation affiliates.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaultor, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the

Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm").

I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.
