

CLASS INFORMATION

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT US EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION, INC. RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. Classes covered by AHA Rules will be judged according to those rules. Questions not covered by USEF, Inc. rules or Arabian Horse Association rules will be decided by the Show Committee whose decision will be final.

Horses placing first, second or third in certain qualifying classes are **required** to show in the respective championship classes or **forfeit winnings**. Exempted are veterinarian excused horses. If a rider qualifies more than one horse, he/she may choose the one he/she wishes to enter the championship class. To be eligible to show in Performance Championship class, a horse must be properly entered, shown and judged in one qualifying class in the same division or section.

EQUITATION: All equitation classes shall be governed in accordance with USEF Rules as modified by the AHA Equitation Rules in the current AHA Handbook. The Handbook may be obtained by writing AHA, 10805 E. Bethany Drive, Aurora, CO 80014.

AHA MEDAL CLASSES: All AHA Medal Classes are open to juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1. Each AHA Medal class must have a minimum of three (3) competitors with proper appointments in order to have AHA Medal awarded. In AHA Medal classes with less than three (3) competitors, AHA Medal points will be earned. (Article 1982)

AHA SADDLE SEAT EQUITATION MEDAL CLASS: Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF EQ119, Test 1-15 or EC equivalent. Markers shall not be used. (BOD 1/97).

AHA WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP MEDAL CLASS: All contestants will perform rail work and a pattern work as outlined in USEF AR220 and AR224.

AHA HUNTER SEAT NOT TO JUMP MEDAL CLASS: Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual test from EQ113.

SADDLE SEAT & REINING SEAT EQUITATION: Saddle Seat judges are encouraged to request 2+ tests from USEF EQ119, Tests 1-15. Reining Seat judges are encouraged to request 2+ tests from USEF EQ125.

WALK/TROT EQUITATION 10 AND UNDER (any seat): Open to riders 10 years of age and under. Stallions prohibited. As of 1/1/95, a rider must have never been judged in a class at a recognized competition that required canter or lope. No test to be called. See USEF Rule Book for proper attire. Saddle Seat and Hunter Seat: To be judged at a walk and trot. Reining Seat: To be judged at a walk and jog-trot.

WALK/TROT PLEASURE 10 AND UNDER (any seat) - Open to riders 10 years of age and under. Stallions prohibited. As of 1/1/95, a rider must have never been judged in a class at a recognized competition that required canter or lope. To be judged on attitude, manners, performance, suitability of horse to rider, quality and conformation. Country Pleasure, English Pleasure, and Hunter Pleasure: To be shown at a walk and normal trot. Western Pleasure: To be shown at a walk and jog-trot.

UPHA ARABIAN BREEDS CHALLENGE CUP 17 & UNDER: Open to all saddle seat equitation riders, 17 years of age and under, riding an Arabian Breeds mare or gelding. Arabians Breeds riders have the option of competing in the UPHA Challenge Cup National or Junior Championship at the American Royal and in their respective breed Championships, however, one win of a UPHA Challenge Cup will not qualify a rider for both Championships. Separate qualifications are required. Arabian Breeds riders can qualify for their respective breed Championships by placing first or second in a UPHA Challenge Cup designated for a particular breed or first through sixth in an open (17 & Under, 14-17, or 13 & Under) UPHA Challenge Cup class.

NSH CLASSES: Added prize money in the amount of \$340 is offered by the National Show Horse Registry. Prize money will be paid to the owner of record according to NSHR records within 30 days of the close of the show. Horse owners are required to provide show management with proof of NSHR registration. A copy of the official NSHR Certificate of Registration or Confirmation Letter must accompany your entry. **Pending registration will not be accepted.**

TO BE ANNOUNCED CLASS (BUY-A-CLASS): To buy a class, you must pay \$50 for the class, in addition to the regular class fees. All Buy-A-Class classes *must be purchased and paid for by entry closing date* so the other exhibitors may be notified. Classes will be sold on a first come-first serve basis (postmark date of entry - no telephone requests).
