## MEMORIAL TROPHY

IVAN E. ROWE MEMORIAL TROPHY - *Awarded to Western Pleasure Open Champion*

The Ivan E. Rowe Memorial Trophy was established in 1974 by Jean Rowe her son, Bob and daughter Nita, as a continuing memorial to their husband and father, Ivan E. Rowe. Mr. Rowe was a charter member of the Oklahoma Arabian Horse Club and served many years as its leader, as well as president of the International Arabian Horse Association. The original Italian made ceramic trophy, which had become fragile over the 23 years it was awarded, was replaced in 1997 with a bronze entitled "Wild Fire" by artist, Carol Cunningham.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The trophy is a "traveling" trophy awarded each year. It is the responsibility of the recipients to have the trophies insured while they are in their possession. The trophies are to be returned to the Oklahoma Arabian Horse Club by April 1st in the year following receipt of these awards, if the recipient is NOT attending the current show

## HIGH POINT SPORT HORSE

Sport Horse High Point and Reserve High Point awards will be given for both the Purebred and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian divisions. An embroidered bridle bag will be awarded to the High Point winners and an embroidered garment bag will be awarded to the Reserve High Point winners. These awards are being sponsored by Chili Pepper Farm. The awards will be announced and presented Friday afternoon in Center Ring at the end of the afternoon session. The show photographer will be present.

TO QUALIFY, points will be awarded for all classes in the Sport Horse Division. Points will follow the horse. The horse will accumulate points based on class placings. The class placings are first through sixth so the points will be awarded as follows: 1st = 6 points, 2nd = 5 points, 3rd = 4 points, 4th = 3 points, 5th = 2 points, and 6th = 1 point. The horse with the highest number of points will be awarded the bridle bag. The horse with the second highest number of points will be awarded the garment bag.

## MOST CLASSIC HEAD

To the Winner of the “Arabian Most Classic Head” class, in addition to the ribbon and trophy, a \$50 cash award will be given. Cash award sponsored by White Wolf Farm.

## RANDOM CASH GIVE-AWAY BONUS

A random cash bonus will be given in the ATR Arabian and HA/AA Mounted Native Costume classes in addition to the 12 BONUS classes during the Championship session. **You will be eligible for the Cash by just riding in the Class.** The winning number will be drawn during the class and announced at the end of the class. Any rider in the class could win—you do not have to place. See the Class Schedule - the eligible classes are designated at the end of the class name by the word 'BONUS' with the amount of the award.
